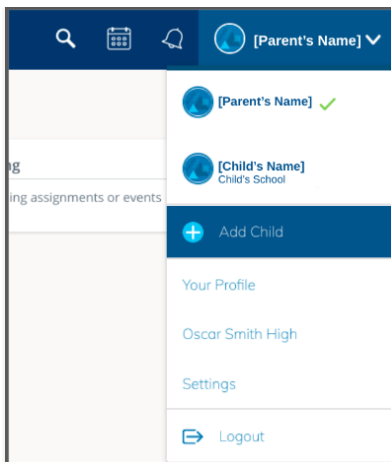


¿Cómo agrego otro niño?
