Targeted Areas

Staff make explicit connections to our faith in their classrooms, at school events, and through social justice projects, such as school wide meals at Thanksgiving and Easter, and volunteering in the community. Youth Ministry and faith retreats help to form students' faith and encourage them to grow in their relationship with Christ.

The mental health of students is supported by access to school counsellors, a family school counsellor, and referrals to outside agencies when needed. Staff have received training on trauma informed practice to help provide a safe and caring environment.

Students from diverse backgrounds excel academically through a culture of success. St. Patrick's continues its commitment to academic excellence. While providing support for all learners, our students consistently achieve above the provincial average on Provincial Achievement Tests.
