Highlights

- 95% of students would recommend St. Patrick's Community School to a friend.
- 95% of parents and students agreed that students have access to the appropriate services at school such as social emotional support and connection to resources in the community.
- In Grade 6 and 9 Provincial Achievement Tests, 14.6% of students achieved a standard of excellence and 77.5% of students met the acceptable standard.
- 91.8% percent of parents are satisfied with their involvement in decisions about their child's education.
